



Recommendation 740 (1974)¹

Situation in Portugal

Parliamentary Assembly

The Assembly,

- 1. Following developments in Portugal with the utmost attention;
- 2. Having heard Mr Soares, Minister for Foreign Affairs of Portugal,
- 3. Expresses the profound hope that the process of democratisation under way in Portugal will continue smoothly and without hindrance, as has been the case since 25 April 1974;
- 4. Maintains its encouragement and full support for this process and for all who are engaged in this difficult task;
- 5. Earnestly appeals to the governments of all democratic European countries to provide the provisional government in Portugal, as a matter of urgency, with all possible economic, technological and technical aid, so as to facilitate the return to democratic and stable institutions;
- 6. Recommends that the Committee of Ministers approach the Portuguese authorities without delay with a view to ascertaining in what activities Portugal may wish to take part forthwith, on either a permanent or an ad hoc basis, until such time as it qualifies for full membership of the Council of Europe.
